COMEDK UGET 2021: Normalisation process and tie breaker rules adopted by ${\tt COMEDK}$

In view of the COVID-19 pandemic and the applicable COVID appropriate protocols, the examination of COMEDK UGET 2021 / Uni-GAUGE E 2021 is planned to accommodate only 50% of the candidates in all the test centers, which has necessitated the exam to be of 2 sessions, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

The academic team of COMEDK UGET 2021 / Uni-GAUGE E 2021 have taken every care to ensure equitable subject coverage and difficulty levels and normalization of the 2 sets of question paper of morning and afternoon sessions in line with the practice adopted by IIT's.

COMEDK has published the Information Brochure on 19.03.2021 wherein at para 19.2 at page 22 it was informed that details of normalisation procedure adopted will be published in a separate document before the exam and a certain set of tie breaking rules were mentioned.

In view of exam being conducted in two sessions, it is decided that the test scores of the candidates will be taken in percentile for announcing rank.

Percentile is derived by "Percentage of candidates who have got equal to or lower score than the candidate". This percentile is normalized between the 2 sessions.

In case of ties in the total percentile scores, if any, the same will be resolved using the following revised tie breaking rules, in the order specified:

- 1) Higher Percentile score of Physics and Mathematics marks taken together.
- 2) Higher Percentile score in Mathematics.
- 3) Higher Percentile score in Chemistry.
- 4) Age of the Candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.

All other terms and conditions brought out in the Information Brochure dtd. 19.03.2021 and subsequent notifications will prevail to the extent not contrary to this notification.
